What can go in the Blue Bag?

The blue bag system is designed to accept household paper, cardboard, deposit items, tin & plastic containers. Please fold down and collapse all cardboard you intend for recycling into blue bags. Uncollapsed cardboard will not be collected. No glass other than deposit items will be collected.

*When will they Collect
the Blue Bags?*

Collection occurs weekly on Fridays starting Dec. 1, 2010. Please have blue bags at your regular garbage location by 7 AM. Keep blue bags at least **3 feet away** from regular garbage. Blue bags must be out in the open and clearly visible. Blue bags in garbage enclosures or containers will not be collected. Items in clear or black bags will not be collected.

**What can
I recycle?**

Newsprint/Heavy paper: newspaper, magazines, phone books, catalogues, flyers

Mixed Paper: office paper, junk mail, shredded paper, etc.

Boxboard: cereal boxes, pasta boxes, etc.

Containers: milk jugs & cartons, food cans, deposit containers, plastic containers #1-7

Corrugated cardboard: flattened and fit inside the blue bag
