

BYLAW 623-2003

"Bylaw to Repeal Access of Municipal Government Information"

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL ACCESS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT INFORMATION FOR THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 AND amendments thereto, provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass Bylaws; and

WHEREAS the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP) has superceded Bylaw 515-97; and

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Fox Creek deems it necessary to Repeal Bylaw 515-97;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fox Creek duly assembled and pursuant to the provisions of the said Municipal Government Act and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 515-97

The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP) supercedes Bylaw 515-97, therefore, Council hereby Repeals Bylaw 515-97.


2. This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
