

BY-LAW NO. 352-89

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BY-LAW 341-88, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATING OF CERTAIN BUSINESSES, CALLINGS, TRADERS, OCCUPATION, AND EMPLOYMENT.

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Fox Creek, in the Province of Alberta, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, being thereto, may pass by-laws for the purpose of regulating and controlling businesses being carried on within the Town of Fox Creek in the Province of Alberta; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Fox Creek has established a by-law for the purpose of regulating and controlling businesses being carried on within the Town of Fox Creek; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Fox Creek deems it necessary to amend By-law 341-88.


NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Section 7 (b) (iii) be amended by changing the licence fee for all resident businesses from \$100.00 per annum to \$50.00 per annum.
2. THAT this By-law shall come into effect on January 1, 1990.


