

BYLAW 632-2004

"The FOIP Appointments Bylaw"

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE HEAD OF THE LOCAL
PUBLIC BODY AND THE APPOINTMENT OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT (FOIP) COORDINATOR**

PURSUANT TO provisions with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, Section 1 (f) (iii), Section 95(a) and Section 85; Council of the Town of Fox Creek, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That the Town Manager for the Town of Fox Creek be appointed "The Head of the Local Public Body for the purposes of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy in the Town of Fox Creek, and
2. That the Community Services Facilitator for the Town of Fox Creek, Kim Palmer, be appointed FOIP Coordinator for the Town of Fox Creek.
3. Should the position of Town Manager for the Town of Fox Creek be vacant, the position of "the Head of the Local Public Body" for the Town of Fox Creek shall be that person appointed as Acting Town Manager for the Town of Fox Creek.
4. Should the position of "FOIP Coordinator" for the Town of Fox Creek be vacant, the position shall be assumed by the Town Manager for the Town of Fox Creek or by appointment by Resolution of Council.
5. This Bylaw shall come into effect on the date of final passing thereof.
6. This Bylaw shall repeal Bylaw 614-2003 upon the date of final passing thereof.
