

BY-LAW NUMBER 220-78

A BY-LAW FOR THE NEW TOWN OF FOX CREEK TO
REGULATE THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK WITHIN
THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

PURSUANT to Section 161 of the Municipal Government
Act, the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Fox Creek
duly assembled does hereby enact the following;

1.) THAT no person shall harbour any horse, head of cattle,
goats, sheep, or any other animals defined in the Stray Animals Act
Section 1 (d) (i), as livestock, within 500 feet of any area having
a land use designated as Residential under By-law 31 and;


2.) THAT no person shall harbour any horse, head of cattle,
goats, sheep, or any other animals defined in the Stray Animals Act
Section 1 (d) (i) as livestock, within 500 feet of any area having
a designated land use under By-law 31 except by an approved
development permit signed by the Development Control Officer and;

THAT this by-law shall take effect on the day of
its passing.

READ a FIRST time this 24th day of January, 1978 A.D.

READ a SECOND time this 14th day of February, 1978, A.D.

READ a THIRD and FINAL time this 14th day of February, 1978 A.D.
