

BY-LAW NO. 47

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE PLUMBING INSTALLATION  
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE NEW TOWN OF FOX CREEK.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers granted the Board of Administrators under the Municipal Government Act, it being Chapter 68, 1968, and the Public Health Act (plumbing regulations) 1968, the Board of Administrators deem it advisable to regulate plumbing installation within the limits of the New Town of Fox Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it advisable to require a special vent be installed to facilitate the connection of future utility units in the basement of all new housing construction to be done within the limits of the new Town of Fox Creek.

THEREFORE, the Board now requires the installation of an extra vent pipe installed, to connect to the roof, and extend to the ceiling of the basement of all new housing units in such a way that it may be connected to future utility units that may be installed in the basement of the housing unit.
