

BYLAW NO.590-2001

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH RULES, REGULATIONS AND FEES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FOX CREEK R.V. CAMPGROUND

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Fox Creek, in the Province of Alberta, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Statutes of Alberta and amendments thereto, may pass by-laws for the purpose of regulating and operating a municipal campground within the Town of Fox Creek.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town Manager of the Town of Fox Creek shall be responsible for the management of the Fox Creek R.V. campground in accordance with this Bylaw and the regulations regarding the campgrounds operation as established by the Council of the Town of Fox Creek.
2. Regulations for the operation of the Fox Creek R.V. Campground are hereby adopted as outlined on Appendix "A" attached to this Bylaw. The Council of the Town of Fox Creek may amend these regulations by resolution when it is deemed appropriate by the Council, without the need to repeal or amend this Bylaw.
3. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Town of Fox Creek, or a Peace Officer may enforce this Bylaw by such measures as may be deemed necessary to ensure that the Bylaw is complied with, including the issuance of tickets or eviction from the campground as outlined herein.
4. The Bylaw Enforcement Officer, authorized by the Town Manager, or a Peace Officer may evict an individual or group of individuals from the Fox Creek R. V. Campground if those individuals are creating a nuisance, or in breach of this Bylaw or its regulations, or if they are interfering with the quiet enjoyment of other campers.
5. (a) Any person contravening any provision of this Bylaw shall be liable upon conviction therefore to a fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$1,000 exclusive of costs, an in case of non-payment of the fine, and costs so imposed; and


(b) Where the offence is non-payment of any camping fees as established by the regulation, the payment of the camping fee shall be in addition to the fines and penalties imposed. Fines and penalties are as defined in Bylaw No. 559-200, the "Fees and Charges Bylaw."
6. This Bylaw shall come into force upon final passing thereof and upon taking effect, Bylaw 397-91 is repealed.



Appendix "A"
Regulation for Operation of Fox Creek
Full Service R. V. Campground

Drive Cautiously:

Children may be playing in the area and campground roads are used as paths. Maximum speed is 20 km/h.

Be careful with your Campfire:

Your negligence could result in a destructive forest fire. Campfires are permitted in fireplaces only and must be attended at all times.

Enjoy your Campfires here:

Firewood is provided for your convenience, to be used on site.

Share the Facilities:

Shower & Washrooms may not be used in such a way that limits use by others.

Be considerate of others:

Help yourself and other campers enjoy the peace and tranquility of the Campground by refraining from rowdy behavior or excessive noise.

Control your Pets:

To protect your pet, local wildlife and other campers, please keep your pets on a leash during your stay.

Keep all vehicles on designated roads:

Trees and greenery are what beautifies the Campground. By wandering off roads, your vehicle kills plants and damages tree roots, resulting in patches of bare soil.

Off Highway vehicles may be operated only on campground roadways or designated areas.

Recreation areas are not for shooting:

Discharging firearms is strictly prohibited in this campground and within the Town Boundaries.

Dressing of big game shall not take place in the Campground.

Use, but do not abuse:

Enjoy the natural beauty and recreation facilities here, but please protect them for your next visit and for other campers.

Trails are provided for your enjoyment:

Please stay on designated trails and use them only for the activity for which they are intended.

Equestrian users:

Please do not bring horses into the Campground.

Fees:

To help maintain this campground, the nightly charge is \$14.00 for serviced sites and \$11.00 for non-serviced sites, to be remitted through the self-registration system. Adults 60 and over qualify for the Senior Rate of \$12.00/\$9.00 per night.

Right of Entry:

Town of Fox Creek employees or RCMP may enter the premises and/or the property if it is deemed necessary to do so.

Violation of any of the above rules may result in a charge and/or eviction by a Town of Fox Creek Employee or the R.C.M.P.
