

BY-LAW NO. 407-91

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF
FOX CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF
ALBERTA TO REPEAL THE FOX
CREEK BUILDING PERMIT BY LAW
NO. 355-89.**

WHEREAS Council of the Town of Fox Creek, in the Province of Alberta, under the authority of Section 109.3.a of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, 1980 R.S.A. is empowered to repeal existing by-laws; and

WHEREAS the Town of Fox Creek, has had its authority pursuant to the Uniform Building Standards Act, R.S.A. rescinded by a Ministerial Order signed on October 8th, 1991 A.D., and

WHEREAS the issuance of all building permits in the Town of Fox Creek is henceforth a responsibility of the Alberta Government, Department of Labour;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That By-law No. 355-89, being a by-law of the Town of Fox Creek, regulating the form, content, and cost of permits for the use, occupancy, relocation, construction, or demolition of buildings, and referred to as the Fox Creek Building Permit By-law 1989, **BE REPEALED.**
