

BY-LAW NUMBER 170-74

By-law #170-74 is a by-law to authorize the Board of Administrators of the New Town of Fox Creek to cause the nuisance grounds to be posted with "No Shooting" signs and to provide a penalty for contravention of this by-law, pursuant to Section 152, (1) (d) and Section 411 of the Municipal Government Act (Part 8) being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970 with amendments up to and including November 22, 1972.

The Board of Administrators of the New Town of Fox Creek duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

Public Notice is hereby given that the discharge of guns or other firearms will be prohibited at or in the nuisance grounds, being PT N.E. 21-62-19-W5M
PT N.W. 22

Any person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term of not more than 6 months, or to a fine of not more than \$500.00, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
