

BYLAW 592-2002

Being a Bylaw of the Town of Fox Creek, in the Province of Alberta, to Amend Bylaw Number 209-77, and Amendments thereto, to Regulate Highway Traffic.

WHEREAS, Under the Authority and Subject to the Provisions of the Highway Traffic Act, Chapter H-7, RSA 1980, and Amendments thereto, the Town of Fox Creek Duly Assembled Enacts by Amendment the Following Regulations to Control Highway Traffic Within Its Corporate Boundaries:

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOX CREEK DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Bylaw 209-77 be amended to include as part of "Section 10 – General", the following:
 17. No person shall clear snow, ice, mud or slush, grass clippings, leaves or any other obstruction onto a public street or sidewalk, boulevard, or other public property.
2. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
