REMINDER: TRAFFIC CONTROL BYLAW 660-2006

A recreational vehicle may be parked in a residential district providing the vehicle is contained entirely within the residents property line:

For the period April 1st to November 30th, the recreational vehicle must be parked no closer than 1 metre from the interior edge of the sidewalk, or within 2 metres from the curb in the event there is no sidewalk. The vehicle may not be parked on any roadway for more than a 72 hour period.



Paying attention to common household activities will reduce encounters and contribute to a Bearsmart community.

- **Manage your garbage properly. If possible, use bear-proof containers.**
- **Bring pet food and feeding dishes inside overnight.**
- **Be compost-wise! Compost can be a significant attractant for bears. Community composting in a secure compound is the best approach.**
- **Don't feed wildlife. This can lead to wildlife becoming accustomed to people, which can trigger dangerous encounters.**
- **Inform your neighbors and visitors if you see a bear near your home.**

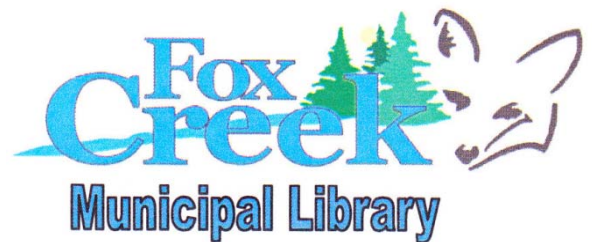

The waste must be placed in a clear garbage bag (not to exceed 30 x 38 in size), or in a labeled container.

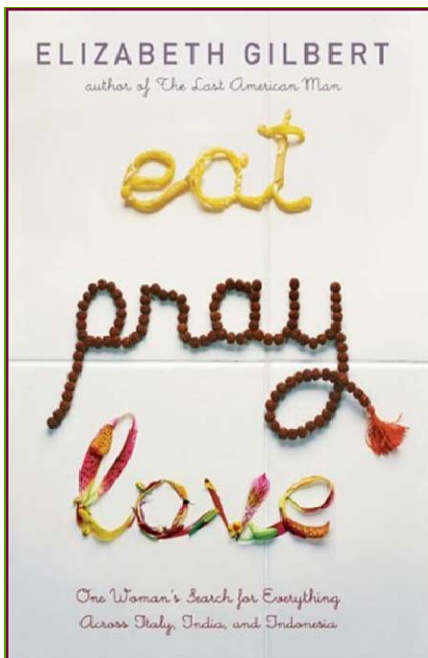
